Objectives

- Describe background information and logistics pertaining to an HIV and Aging survey among South Carolina residents age 50 years and older
- Discuss selected results among individuals that completed the survey within a specified timeframe
- Explore key take-home points and lessons learned from the survey development and distribution process

Survey Information

- Developed in partnership between the HIV Planning Council (HPC) and the Healthy Futures Lab at USC
- Submitted to and approved by the USC Institutional Review Board by Dr. Sayward Harrison
- Eligibility criteria included:
 - Living with HIV
 - Age 50 years or older
 - Resident of South Carolina

Survey Methods & Dates

- Paper surveys available at 2019 SC HIV, STD, and Viral Hepatitis Conference
- * A drawing of four \$25 gift cards took place at the end of the conference
- * Emails/cell phone numbers were kept separate from anonymous surveys
- Web-based survey available from December 17, 2019 to February 19, 2021
- All paper surveys were entered into SurveyMonkey to create one final dataset



Participants & Socio-Demographics

- 64 individuals initiated the survey
 - Out of those, 50 completed all items on the survey

- Mean Age = 55.8 years
 - Range = 50 72 years of age






In the past month, have you needed help getting enough food or the right kinds of food to eat?






Do you have a physical condition that prevents you from doing everything you need/want to do?









After testing positive, when did you have your first medical appointment with an HIV medical provider?






To the best of your knowledge, how did you acquire HIV (check all that apply)?









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What was your most recent viral load?

- Surveys were not peer-reviewed by certified translators and not distributed for public use



Key points from HIV & Aging Needs Assessment Survey development and distribution

Survey compiled by diverse group of healthcare personnel, patient advocates, and consumers

Survey distribution negatively impacted by restrictions from COVID-19 pandemic

Document length was reported as a barrier for participating and completing the entire survey

Lack of consistent incentives to participate in the survey for respondents and representatives assisting respondents with completion

Appeared to be an increase in the number of items skipped towards the end of the survey

Findings may not completely represent *all* South Carolina residents living with HIV!
